## **JOB SUMMARY:**

Clean, prepare and paint boilers and parts. Mix all paint products and perform functions with little or no supervision.

## **FUNCTIONS TO BE PERFORMED:**

- \*\*\* Clean and inspect parts prior to painting
- \*\*\* Do all required masking on areas not to be painted
- \*\*\* Paint the boilers and all parts with the acceptable quality of finish
- \*\*\* Follow all procedures for a quality lasting paint surface
- \*\*\* Follow proper guidelines for storage and inventory of chemicals and paints
- \*\*\* Be able to mix and spray all products used
- \*\*\* Keep equipment clean and work area clean
- \*\*\* Perform routine maintenance on paint booth and paint equipment
- \*\*\* Perform other related duties as required

## PHYSICAL AND MENTAL REQUIREMENTS:

- \*\*\* Able to communicate verbally and in writing
- \*\*\* Must be capable of following verbal and/or written instructions
- \*\*\* Capable of lifting up to 70 pounds alone and 100 pounds with assistance
- \*\*\* Able to work from ladders and scaffolding
- \*\*\* Able to bend, stoop, twist and squat
- \*\*\* Must be able to work in semi-awkward positions
- \*\*\* Working knowledge of and proper use of all safety equipment
- \*\*\* Must have knowledge of MSDS information as it pertains to chemicals and paints and know where they are located
- \*\*\* Ability to retain information with regard to chemical and paint materials
- \*\*\* No allergic reactions to paint, dust, or other related paint materials
- \*\*\* Be able to determine the proper surface condition for acceptance of paint and prepare if required
- \*\*\* Must have full knowledge of quality requirements to produce acceptable finish paint
