## **Job Summary:**

Develops, implements and carries out inventory control procedures and processes to ensure accuracy, efficiency, and compliance.

## **Responsibilities:**

- Monitor inventory levels and track stock movements to maintain optimal inventory levels and prevent overstocking or stockouts
- Conduct regular physical inventory counts to reconcile physical stock with system records and identify discrepancies.
- Coordinate with procurement to ensure timely and adequate stock replenishment.
- Analyze inventory data to identify trends, forecast demand, and recommend adjustments to inventory levels or stock replenishment strategies.
- Conduct regular audits to ensure inventory accuracy, identify discrepancies, and implement corrective actions.
- Maintain accurate and up-to-date inventory records, including item descriptions, quantities, locations, and stock movements.
- Generate regular reports on inventory performance, stock levels, and key metrics for management review.
